9919-001	Additional Training (Quick Response) – Additional training for up to 10 people.
9919-002	Additional Training (Total Response) – Additional training for up to 10 people.
9921-001	Blood Borne Pathogens Training – One hour American Safety and Health Institute (ASHI) training as an add on to training schedule. The course is designed to teach students essential information on transmission and disease potential of common blood borne pathogens— in particular, HIV/AIDS, HBV/Hepatitis B, HCV/Hepatitis C. Students learn what constitutes “occupational exposure,” and review standard exposure control precautions, immunization and vaccination options, work practice controls, use of appropriate personal protective equipment, and accidental exposure reporting and follow-up. The American Safety and Health Institute issues a card with yearly updates.
9921-002	First Aid Training – This 3-hour AHA Heartsaver course provides training in basic first aid procedures for medical emergencies and injuries.
9925-001	AED/CPR for Children – This 1-hour AHA Heartsaver course teaches rescuers AED/CPR and choking skills for children ages 1-8.
9925-002	AED/CPR for Infants – This 1-hour AHA Heartsaver course teaches rescuers AED/CPR and choking skills for infants under the age of 1.
	OPTIONS:
9917-001	Site Assessment – An AED specialist can visit your site to determine the best place to deploy an AED and determine how many AEDs are required. A formal analysis and report is provided.
9927-001	Post Event Data Review and Incident Debriefing Service – Call-in support, assistance with download of data and submission of data as required by state regulation within 24 hours of notification. Service per location per year.
9922-001	Online Refresher Training – Provides a review of the AED/CPR training and concludes with an online quiz. Scores are documented in MasterTrak and are available to the site coordinator. Training is available for the original 10 students trained and is available once per year. Students are reminded via E-minder to take the refresher training.
